He was placed on a couch in the garage/shed and a fire was lit in a trash can to keep him warm. It was freezing that night and was likely in the 'teens of temperature. (b) (6) died of carbon monoxide poisoning at some point in the early morning of January 1, 2000. No charges were ever brought forward against any of the residents of the home, and I am filing this request to get access to documents so that my family and I may finally have answers to why investigators never charged anyone for (b) (6) killing.

I am a Northern Paiute citizen of the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony, and I am writing a paper on (b) (6) case and my hope is that this law article will shed light on the historical and modern disparities that tribal nations in Nevada have faced within the field of criminal law. Since Congressional statutes have authorized only federal agencies to have authority to prosecute Major Crimes in Indian Country, the federal agencies are often the only ones able to prosecute serious crimes. There has been a history of federal agencies struggling to prosecute such crimes and as a result, tribal nations in Nevada have long dealt with communities rife with criminals as well as crime, since there are circumstances where certain crimes go unresolved. Thus, I am hoping to use this example to call for more resources and awareness to federal prosecutors.
