As published in the Federal Register, the PROGRESS Act Negotiated Rulemaking Committee was originally scheduled to convene next week on January 30-February 2, 2023, in Washington, DC, for their first in-person meeting. Although the Federal and Tribal subcommittees have been diligently working to reach consensus on provisions to be considered by the full Committee, there has arisen a need for some additional time for the subcommittee to review and advance a response to the proposed subparts that have been exchanged.
